Collect for the Seventh Sunday after Trinity

Generous God, you give us gifts and make them grow: though our faith is small as mustard seed, make it grow to your glory and the flourishing of your kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Message from Julie

Today's reading is Ephesians 1: 3-14.

Tradition has it that this letter was written by Paul (or an amanuensis) from prison in Rome around AD60. It was a letter not just to the church in Ephesus but probably the surrounding communities where Paul had established churches.

Our passage is one long sentence in the original Greek and provides a rich overview of Paul's understanding of God's plan for the salvation of the world through Christ, His Son. Paul's hymn of praise celebrates the spiritual blessings that we receive in Christ.

God's grace is his abundant undeserved favour towards us. Previously this favour seemed to be reserved for the Jews, as his chosen people. But Paul makes clear that the gift of grace is just that – a gift – and it is available to ALL who believe – Jews and Gentiles. Later Paul will explain, "By grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing, it is the gift of God." (Eph2:8.)

It is God's initiative but we are not passive. We are given new life for good works which God prepared for us beforehand. So grace is not only the means of our salvation through Jesus Christ, but also the empowering presence of God enabling us to live out our Christian lives.

In a nutshell we are:

- Chosen by the Father (vv4-6)
- Redeemed by the Son (vv 7-10)
- Sealed by the Spirit (vv 11-14).

Our lives make much more sense when viewed in light of God's overall plan.

How has God blessed you? How has he equipped you to serve? What might he be calling you to do?
